

Badminton DSA Criteria 2018

Points	0 – 1	2 – 3	4 – 5
Speed and Agility	Pupil does not move fast and his play is restricted by his movements.	Pupil is able to move quickly and change direction.	Pupil is able to respond quickly to different shots and change directions nimbly.
Technique and Coordination	Pupil is unfamiliar with the basic strokes.	Pupil is able to perform most strokes.	Pupil demonstrates a good mastery of the necessary strokes and has a well-coordinated swing.
Control	Pupil has little or no control over his shots.	Pupil shows some rough control over his shots and is able to return the shots over the net.	Pupil shows strong ability in controlling his shots and is able to hit the shuttle to an advantageous position.
Strategic Play	Pupil is just returning the shuttle with little sense of strategy.	Pupil is able to play to his own advantage.	Pupil can play to his own advantage and exploit opponent's weaknesses.
