These are the details:

- 1) Mr Johnny Lau, 6<sup>th</sup> Principal of Dunman Sec from 1985 to 1989 placed
- The Dunman Focus
  - Blazer from Students' Council
  - Collar pins for the Class Committee and
  - Badge of the Student Council

These items represent the development of student leadership in the 1980s.

- 2) Mr Tng Kim Guan, 8<sup>th</sup> Principal of Dunman Sec from 1993 to 1996 placed
- A piece of stained glass from our old stained glass façade; and
  - The Dunmanite Creed

The old stained glass represents our rich legacy and the Dunman creed represents the 5D.

- 3) Mrs Edelweiss Neo, our 11<sup>th</sup> and the longest serving principal of the school from 2001 to 2009 placed:

- Dunman T-shirt
- Dunman school-based curriculum resources
- Newspaper article on the school being awarded the Lee Hsien Loong Award for Innovations in the Normal Course.

These items signify our heritage and commitment to cater to diverse students' needs through innovation.

- 4) Ms Beatrice Chong, our 12<sup>th</sup> Principal from 2010 to 2013 placed:

- Dunman Jubilee items
- And memorabilia into the capsule.

- 5) Mr Ng San Tiong, Chairman of the SAC in 2013 and student of Dunman Secondary in 1968 placed

- School ties

The items symbolise the ties that bind the students to the school.

- 6) Mr Kenn Ching, Chairman of Dunman Secondary Alumni in 2013 placed

- Dunman Secondary School badges

The school badges represent the heritage that links past, present and future students of Dunman.

- 7) Mr See Wee Siang, President of the Student Council in 2013 placed:

- 2013 Quotes of the Week
- one of his own quotes
- Dunman exercise books

These items symbolise the commitment of the school to nurture students who are both virtuous and have the knowledge and skills to make a difference.

8) Mr Tang Kim Yong a student of Dunman who came back to serve as a teacher from 2008 to 2022 placed

- a bottle of seeds
