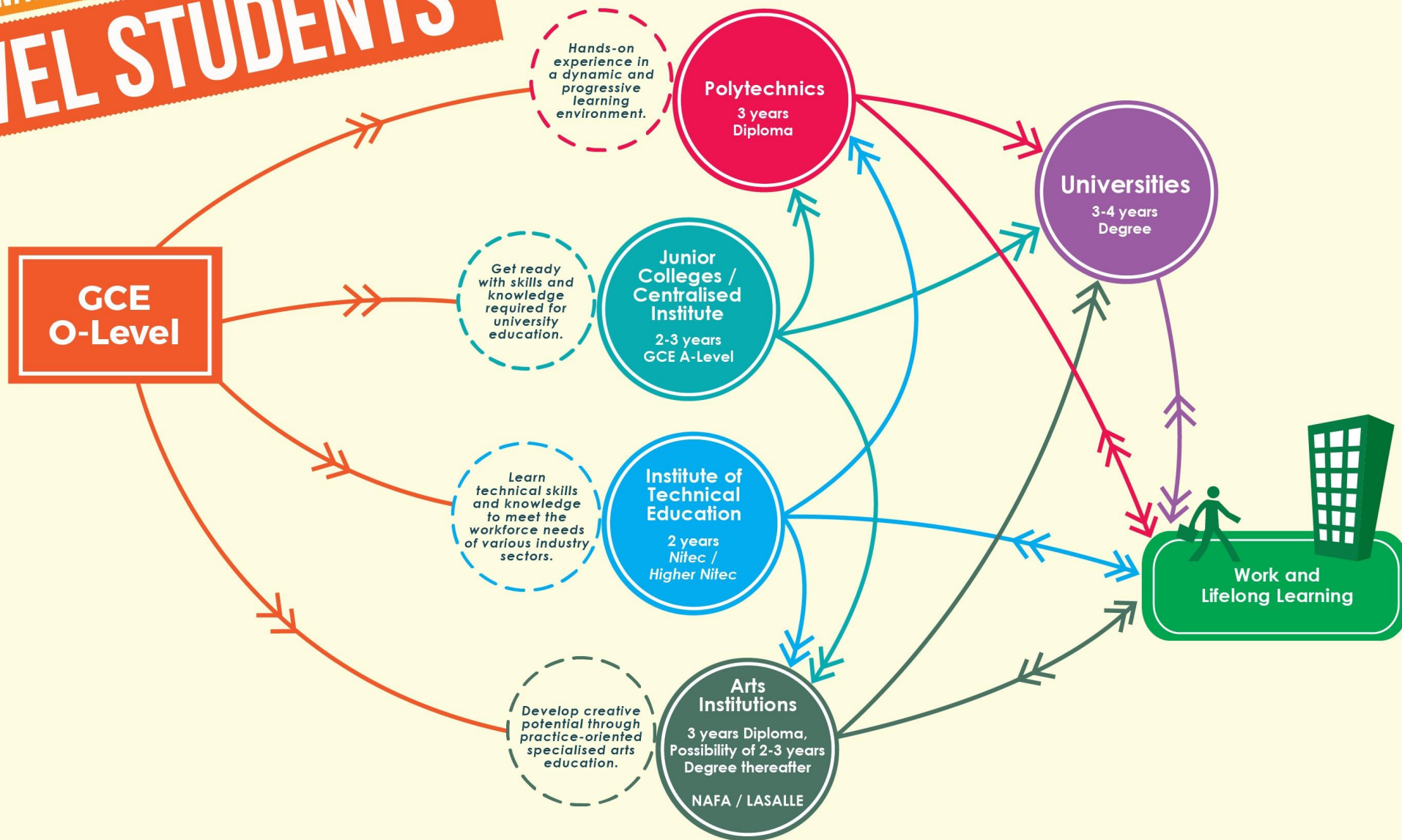

Opportunities to pursue JC courses



Relevant content subjects which allows students to go deeper in their subject mastery

- Physics
- Chemistry
- Biology
- Additional Mathematics
- Literature

From 2024 intake, students applying for admissions to the polytechnics will generally need to meet three subject-specific *Minimum Entry Requirements*

In general, the subject-specific MERs will comprise three subjects*:

EL a. English Language

R2 b. Two relevant subjects drawn from the R subject list for the associated course type

** Exceptions may be made in special circumstances, especially for regulated courses with specific requirements*

To be admitted to polytechnic diploma courses....

You will need to take relevant subjects depending on the course type

There are **4** course types – A, B, C, and D, and courses are broadly categorised according to their nature

A Humanities or Media courses

B Business courses

C Engineering, Science, Facility Management or IT courses

D Architecture or design courses

To be admitted to polytechnic diploma courses....

The subject-specific MERs stipulate the subjects that are required and the minimum grades required for each subject

Subjects that are relevant to the course, and typically comprise subjects relevant to the course type

Student has to attain a pass in EL and a pass in overall percentage of all subjects combined.

Streaming Criteria



- Performance of whole cohort (based on merit)
